GMC Cadets Hold Title of Fastest Team at Bataan Memorial Death March Marathon

On March 25th, five GMC Cadets (Zachary Senger, Jake Toller, Jesse Hall, Nicholas Harripersaud, and Zachary St. Laurent) competed in the 29th annual Bataan Memorial Death March Marathon. Finishing in an astounding 6 hours, 39 minutes, and 42 seconds, the team held their title of fastest team among all junior and senior military colleges and earned the title of fastest team in the First Brigade. Their performance also placed them second among 51 other teams in the "ROTC Team Heavy" category with at least 45 of them being large four year programs. Competing in this category required them to carry 35 pound rucksacks for 26.1 miles over varying terrain ranging from steep paved roads to ankle deep loose desert sand.

The marathon is held annually at White Sands Missile Range in New Mexico and draws over 6,000 competitors from across the nation to honor the sacrifices of the World War II heroes who endured the perilous journey which is known to history as the Bataan Death March. After the fall of the Bataan Peninsula on the Island of Luzon in the Philippines during April 1942, over 60,000 American and Filipino soldiers conducted a brutal forced march in excess of 60 miles to prisoner of war camps. Through the duration of the march, thousands of soldiers died or were executed under the hands of their Japanese captors.
