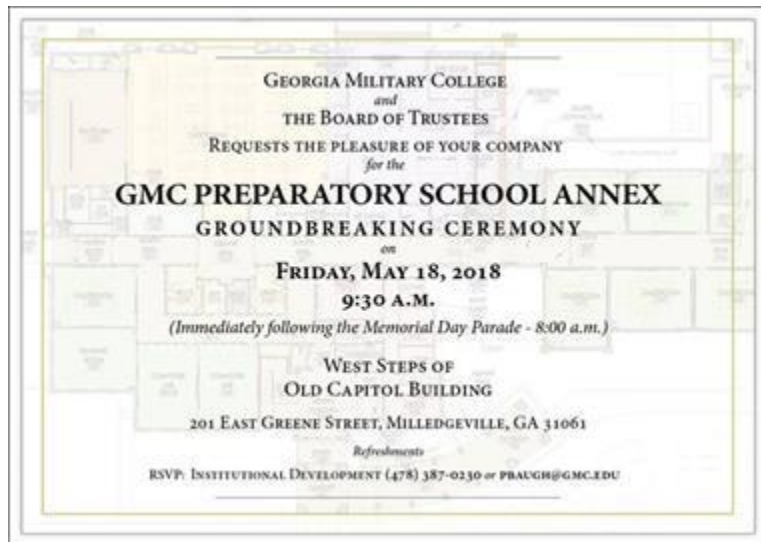

## **GMC Signs 65th Articulation Agreement with the Addition of Southern New Hampshire University - College of Online and Continuing Education**

In 2013, Georgia Military College had 30 signed articulation agreements with other colleges, universities and technical colleges across the nation. As of this Monday, GMC has 65 articulation agreements total, with the addition of Southern New Hampshire University - College of Online and Continuing Education (SNHU-COCE).

In the last 5 years, GMC has more than doubled the number of agreements in its continued efforts to establish pathways for students. SNHU-COCE and Georgia Military College, in the spirit of academic cooperation, signed an articulation agreement in order to facilitate the transfer of graduates of GMC to SNHU. On Monday, May 7, Gayla Freelon, Assistant Director of Academic Alliances at SNHU-COCE, and Lieutenant General William B. Caldwell, IV, President of Georgia Military College, signed the articulation agreement on campus at Georgia Military College.

### **GMC Fine Arts Presents James And The Giant Peach**

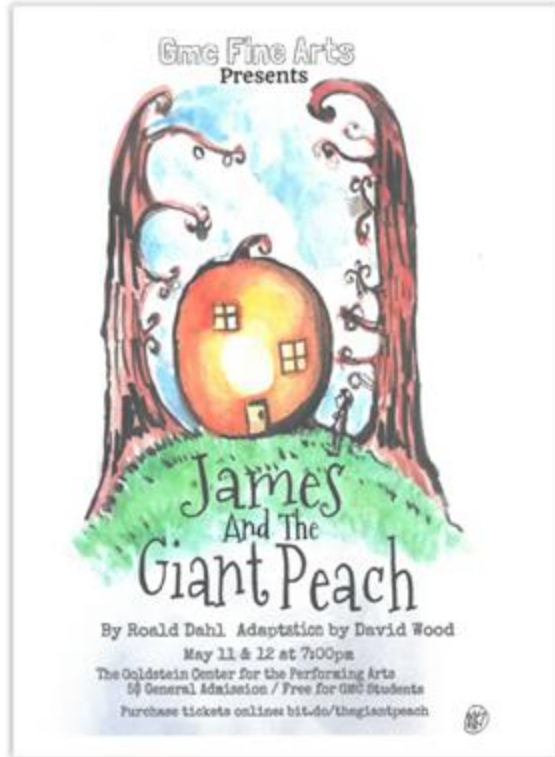
GMC Fine Arts will be performing [James and The Giant Peach](#) this Friday and Saturday evening at The Goldstein Center for the Performing Arts.
