Congratulations to these Raiders!

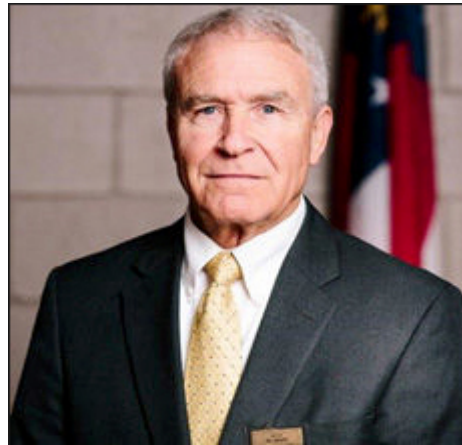




Sheriff Bill Masee to Speak at Academic Honors Parade on Friday, April 20th

We are looking forward to hosting GMC Alumnus and Baldwin County Sheriff Bill Masee on Friday at our Academic Honors Parade as our distinguished speaker. The parade will be held at 2:30pm this Friday on Grant Parade.

Sheriff Bill Masee was born in Milledgeville on October 9, 1946 and educated in the Baldwin County public school system. In 1964 he graduated from Baldwin High School, attended and received an associate's degree from Georgia Military College, and then earned a BBA from Georgia College and State University in 1970.



His law enforcement experience began with the Georgia Bureau of Investigation in 1971, where he served until 1977. He held the position of Chief of Police for the Milledgeville Police Department from 1985-1988. Masee is currently serving an 8th term as Sheriff for Baldwin County. Elected in 1988, he took office on January 1, 1989.

His appointments and elections include active executive board member of the Georgia Sheriff's Association, where he served as past president; member of the Peace Officers Standards and Training Council; past president of the Constitutional Officers Association of Georgia; board member of the Georgia Board of Corrections; graduate of the National FBI Academy.

Bill is married to Jenny T. Masee and has one daughter, Marjorie Gray Masee and a step-daughter Lynsey Harris.

GMC Cadets Conduct Order of the Centurion

GMC Cadets conducted the Order of the Centurion on Saturday, April 14th.

The Order of the Centurion is given to cadets who possess a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or higher, have no disciplinary hours, score a 270 or above on the Army Physical Fitness Test, (the Army's Fit-to-Fight Standard) and complete a 12 mile road march, with a 35-pound rucksack, in three hours or less (the Army's Expert Infantryman's Standards).

Cadet St. Laurent came in first with a time of 2 hours, 23 minutes, and 59 seconds. Each of the cadets gave their all in this grueling event. GMC will need to do some additional analysis to determine who earned the medal in reference to PT scores and GPAs. 3 of the 28 cadets that participated were Prep School Raider Team members.
